### **Sign up as a whole team:**

Recommended minimum 11 players including goalie.

Maximum 16 players including goalie

### **Sign up as a single player or small group (less than 11):**

Single players and small groups will be combined into teams or added to teams willing to take on extra players.

### **Tournament fees:**

Per team: \$600.00 (includes liability insurance)

Single players: \$65.00 (includes liability insurance)

**ALL REGISTRATION FEES ARE FINAL AND NON REFUNDABLE, EXCEPT IN THE EVENT OF DIVISION TERMINATION.**

## **Divisions**

1. Competitive adult co-ed

### **Division requirements**

The minimum requirement is 3 teams per division. In the event that the minimum requirement is not meet the division will: 1. be canceled or 2. be moved up to the next division.

If your division is canceled all registration fees paid will be 100% reimbursed.

### **Schedule**

Depending on the number of teams, schedule and length of each game will be decided after the registration deadline.

### **Tournament Layout:**

Round Robin:

All teams are guaranteed a minimum of 3 round robin games. Round Robin game time will be set to fit the time slots available after all teams register to play. For this years madness 2x11min with a 2 min intermission. There is no sudden or shoot out in round robin.

### **Playoffs:**

All teams will play in the playoff.

Playoff games will be structured as 2x15 min regulation periods with a 3 min intermission.

If necessary, there will be a 5 min sudden death overtime and if needed followed by immediate shoot out to determine a winner. Shoot out will include 3 opportunities per team, followed by 1 opportunity per team until a winner is decided.

### **Game rules**

Each team is allowed 5 players and 1 goalie on the rink at a time. Games will be played according to the international floorball federations rule book. Each game will have 2 referees.

Rules note: IF you are unfamiliar with the rules of floorball PLEASE CLICK [HERE](#) and down load the rule book. We have high lighted the most common rules. If you are used to hockey rules this is a must as MANY things you are used to do are restricted or not allowed.

Don't worry you'll learn quickly and your hockey skills will be a great advantage.

### **Referee Training: (If available)**

**For this Madness there will be no Referee training available**

A referee clinic hosted by an experienced referee from the USA floorball Federation may be offered Friday evening before the tournament. New referees wanting to ref. at the tournament are required to attend this training. New referees will work with an experienced ref. at the event. Players wanting to learn the rules are encouraged to attend.
